Subjective Integration of Probabilistic Information from Description and from Experience

This research compares normative and subjective principles of integrating description- and experience-based probabilistic information. Participants in two experiments estimated the proportion of red balls in a bag on the basis of observing a sequence of draws (experience) and receiving a summary of an independent sample (a description). Subjective integration was more sensitive to experience than description in a manner that depended on source presentation sequence, description format and perceived description trustworthiness. Findings have implications for information integration models, for interpreting the description-experience gap in risky choice, and for developing decision aids.
